Experiences and Outcomes

Main outcomes to be covered this term...

Maths – This term we will be applying our knowledge of addition and subtraction, making the best use of the mental strategies and written skills that we have developed. We will be continuing to count up and down in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's. We will be also looking at measurement and pattern this term.
